

Construction Work in August-September

The foundation work for the school building has progressed to the final section at the English School construction site, and the installation of elements is proceeding at a good pace. Busy site traffic with heavy equipment is mainly caused by element deliveries, concrete and pump trucks, and soil material loads. Delivery times for these loads are being staggered to avoid traffic congestion, but schedules don't always go as planned. Traffic control is in place when element loads arrive at the site.

Pedestrian traffic on Eliel Saarisen tie next to the construction site is closed until the construction work allows the heavy fence to be moved closer to the building. Work on the street area will likely include filling and connection work. The goal is to operate only within the boundaries of the plot as soon as possible.

The site office has moved to the site cabins.

Extra caution is required near large vehicles, especially with children. It is very difficult for drivers to see individual people around the vehicle.

- Completion of foundation
- Installation of elements
- Connection work
- Filling, drainage and area piping
